with Firefighter Dayna.

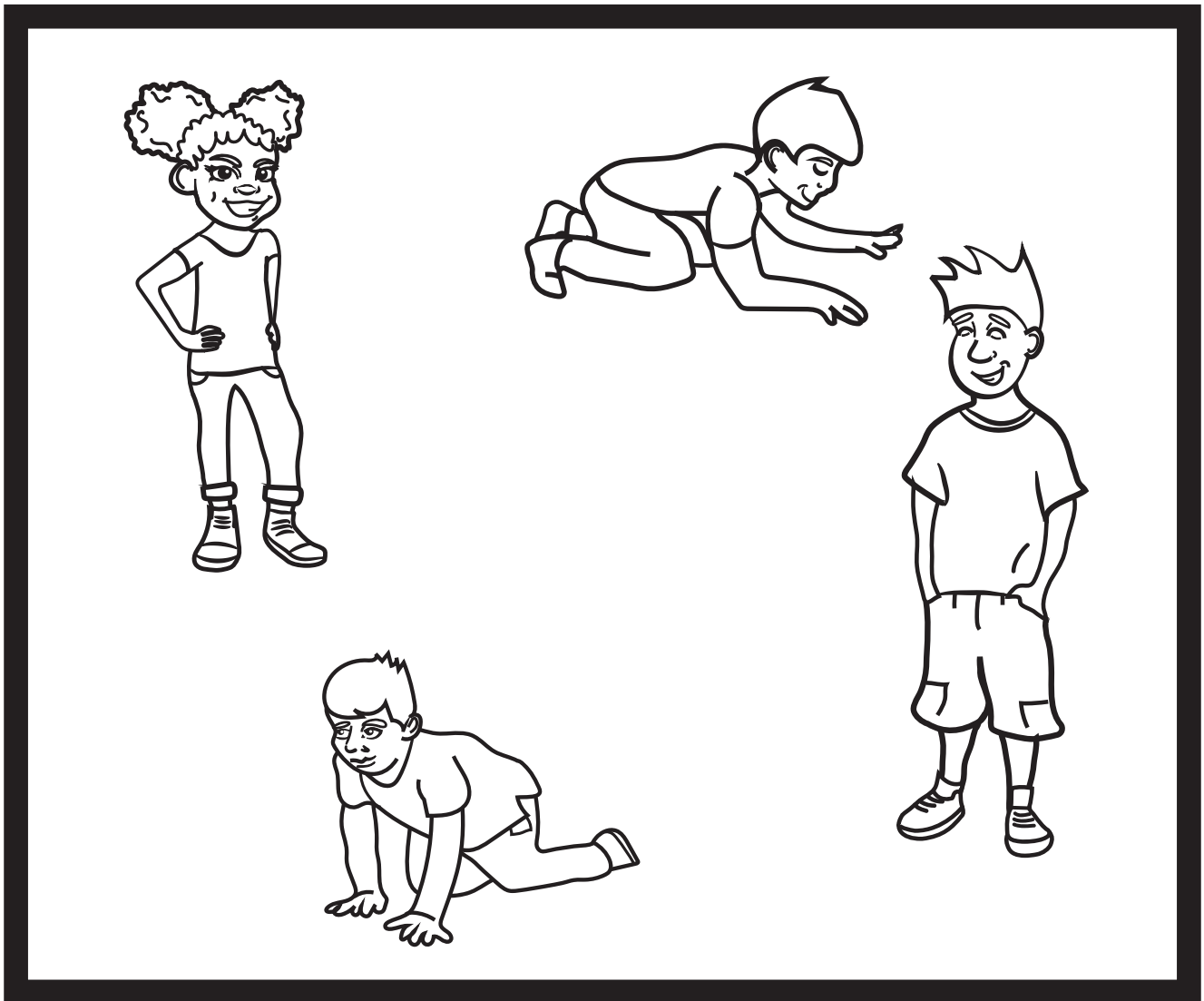
