




Molly the Fire Safety Dog loves helping at the firehouse.



Draw a picture of Molly at the firehouse.




Do you see Molly at the firehouse? She is helping Firefighter Dayna wash the fire truck.




Molly loves to teach fire safety with Firefighter Dayna.




Draw your escape map here. Remember to include your meeting place!




Crawl low if you see or smell smoke. Get out and stay out!




Circle the children who are crawling low.








Replace batteries in smoke alarms every six months and test them regularly!


